

IASLT stands for the Irish Association of Speech and Language Therapists.

**Student members** must be studying for a professional qualification in speech and language therapy in Ireland, UK, USA, Canada, Australia or New Zealand.

Recognition of qualifications is not required as a student member. For those who qualify outside of the Republic of Ireland, recognition is required before transfer to all other membership categories except international member.

The membership year starts from the date of joining and renewal is due 12 months after this date.

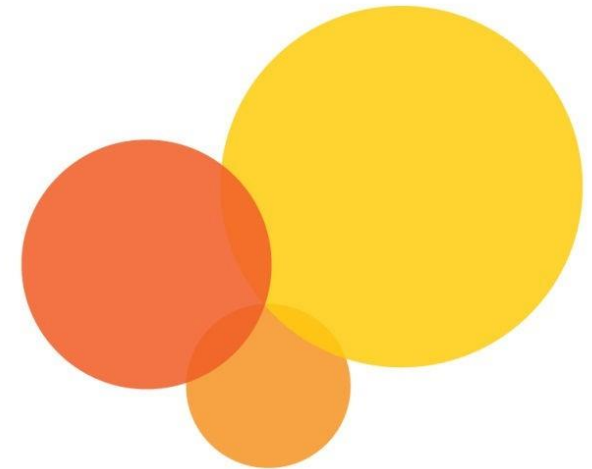

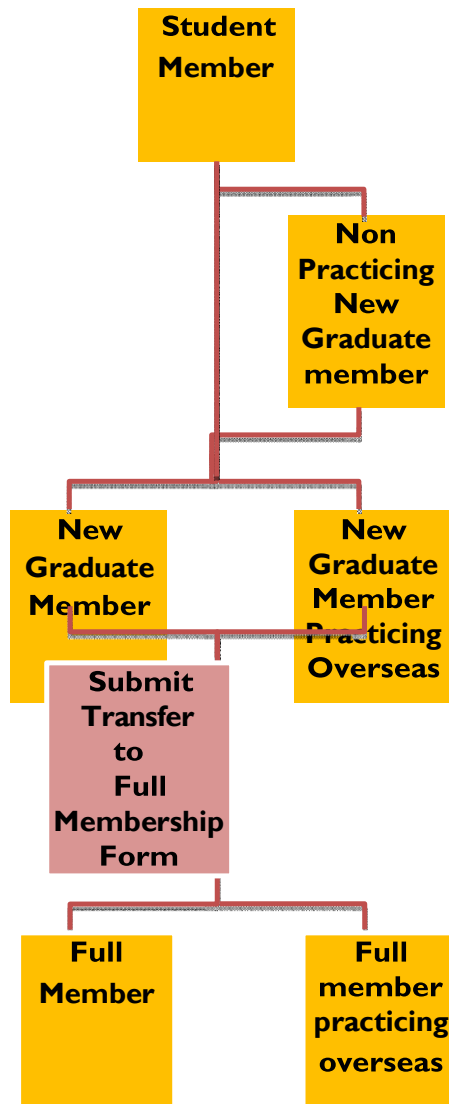
