

Online learning courses for people working in health and social care services

ABOUT

HIQA develops national standards for health and social care services to make sure that people using these services receive the best possible care and support.

We also develop support materials, such as online learning courses, to support staff working in health and social care services to understand and implement national standards in their day-to-day work. These courses are also beneficial to health and social care students.

Each course has a mix of content, with videos, scenarios, quizzes and knowledge tests, and links to additional resources to extend learning.

COURSES

Infection prevention and control

The course introduces the national standards for infection prevention and control in community services, and shows practical ways of applying the standards.



Adult safeguarding

The course, developed in partnership with the Mental Health Commission, introduces the national standards for adult safeguarding, and provides examples of how the principles underpinning the standards might look in practice.



Applying a human rights-based approach in health and social care

The course builds on HIQA's Guidance on a Human Rights-based Approach in Health and Social Care Services. There are four modules which support learners to put important elements of a human rights-based approach into practice.



Information Management - Data Quality

The course aims to improve knowledge and skills in the area of data quality in health and social care services and organisations.



The fundamentals of Advocacy

The course aims to enhance understanding of advocacy and enable staff to better support people to advocate for themselves and to access advocacy services.
